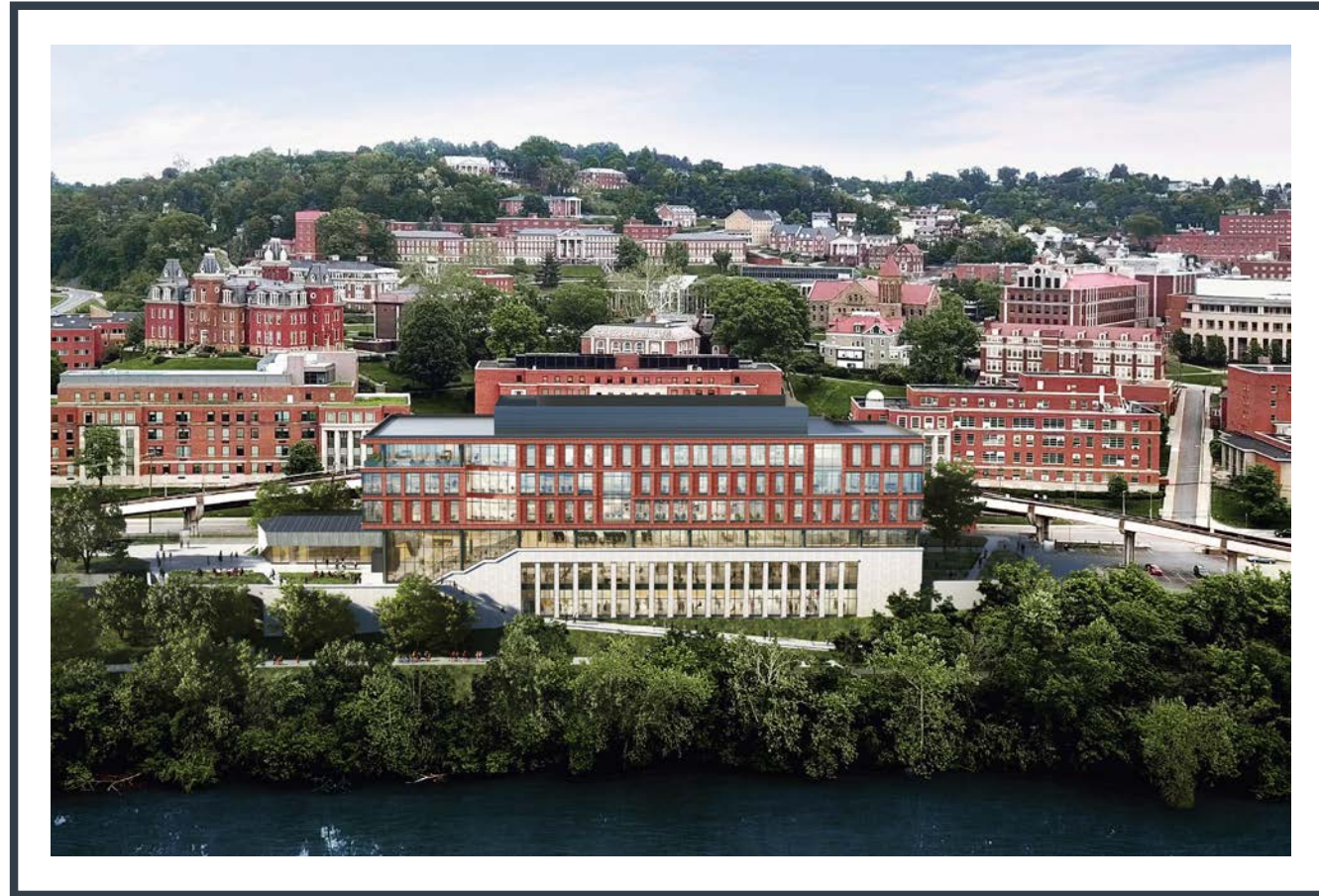

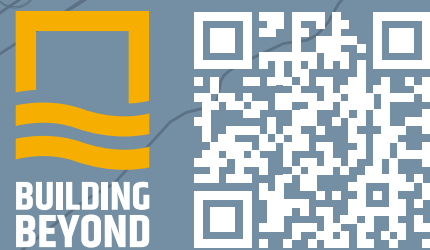

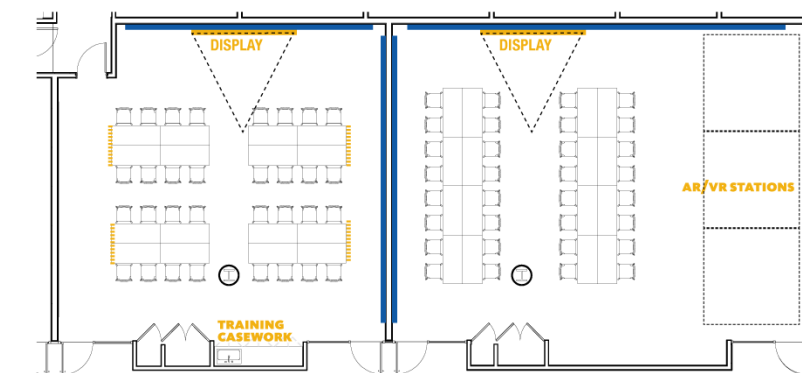
ROLL CAPITAL MARKETS CENTER

A FUTURE IN FOCUS

As our team continues to grow, we are now home to nearly 100 faculty and 60 staff who bring emerging ideas into our College.

Faculty and staff will acquire state-of-the-art technology in conference rooms and classrooms equipped with wireless connectivity, display screens and collaboration software, as well as community lounges, a Genius Bar and an IT Help Desk.






ACADEMIC ENGAGEMENT SUCCESS CENTER

The AeSC will nearly double in space. It will include private study rooms and collaborative workspace equipped with computers and staff to help students with writing, study skills and tutoring in the core business subjects.

The BCC will continue to offer assistance and tutoring in writing, oral communication, presentation preparation, library research and Adobe design skills.

Lecture Hall Expansion: a 250-seat auditorium will reflect a standard style, but will be outfitted with a high-tech control room for lectures and presentations.

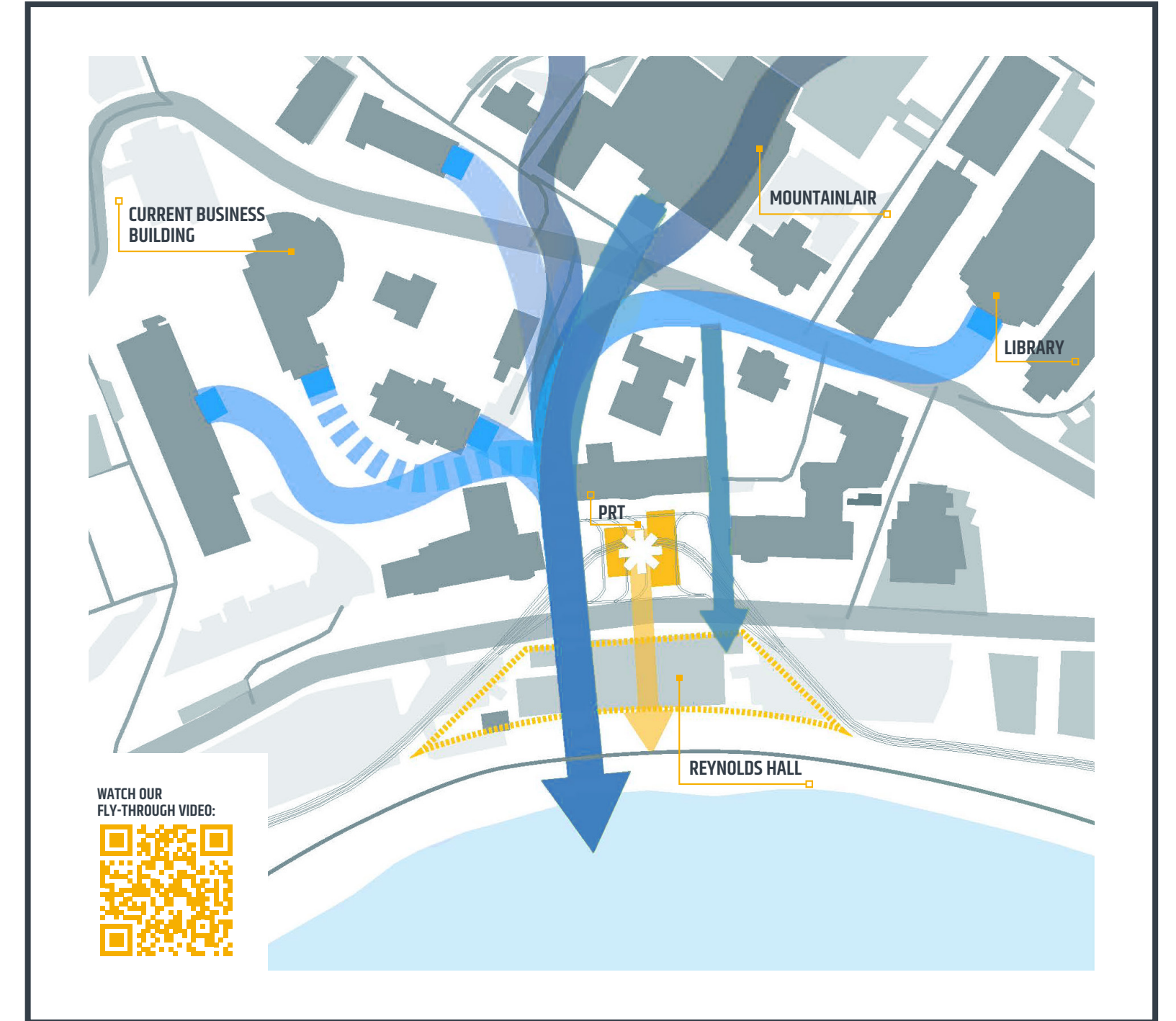


CENTER FOR CAREER DEVELOPMENT

Boasting a river view, the Terrace will be a place for students and faculty to relax and a space to entertain alumni and friends of the Chambers College.

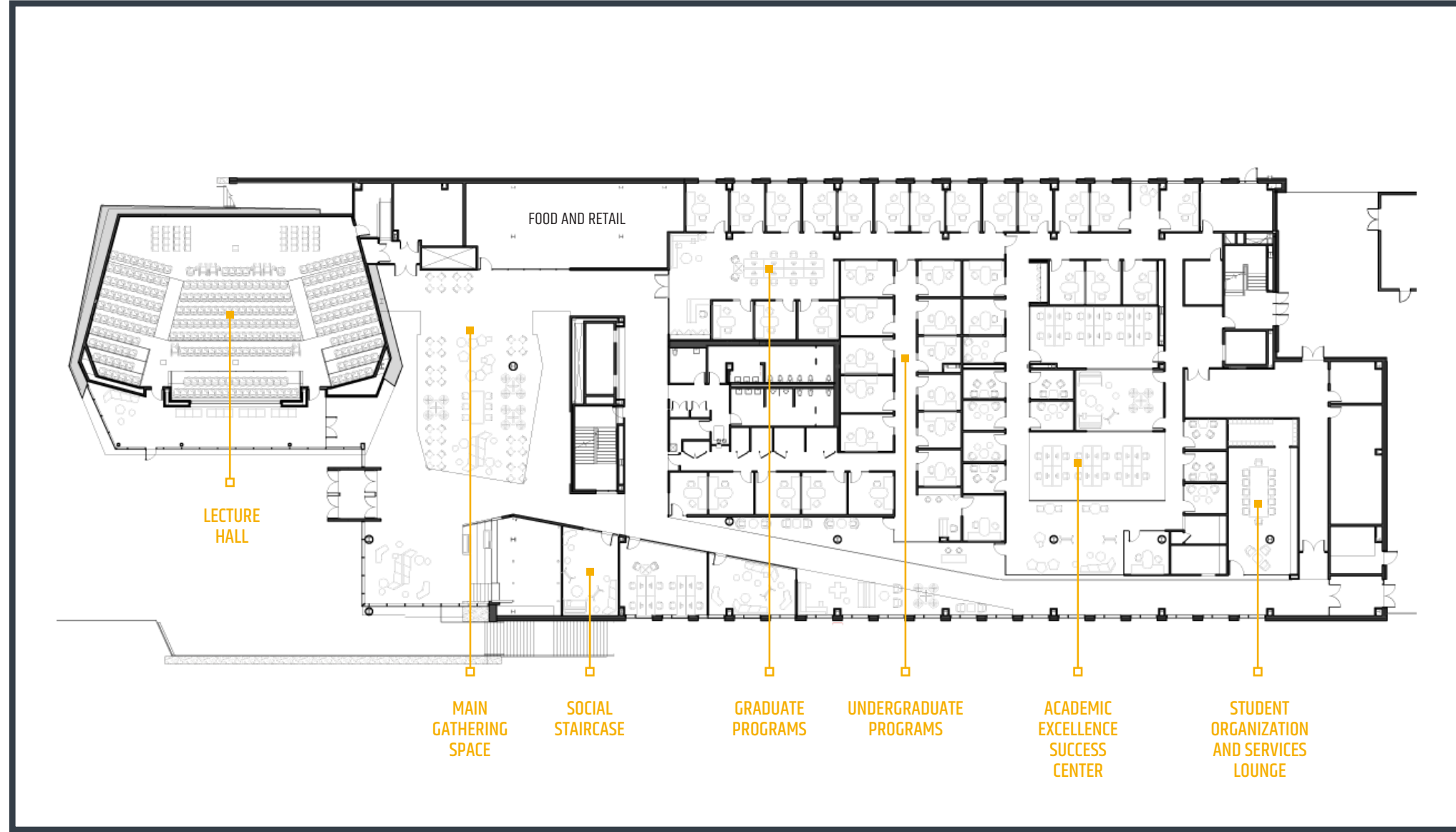


TRANSFORMING OUR WATERFRONT

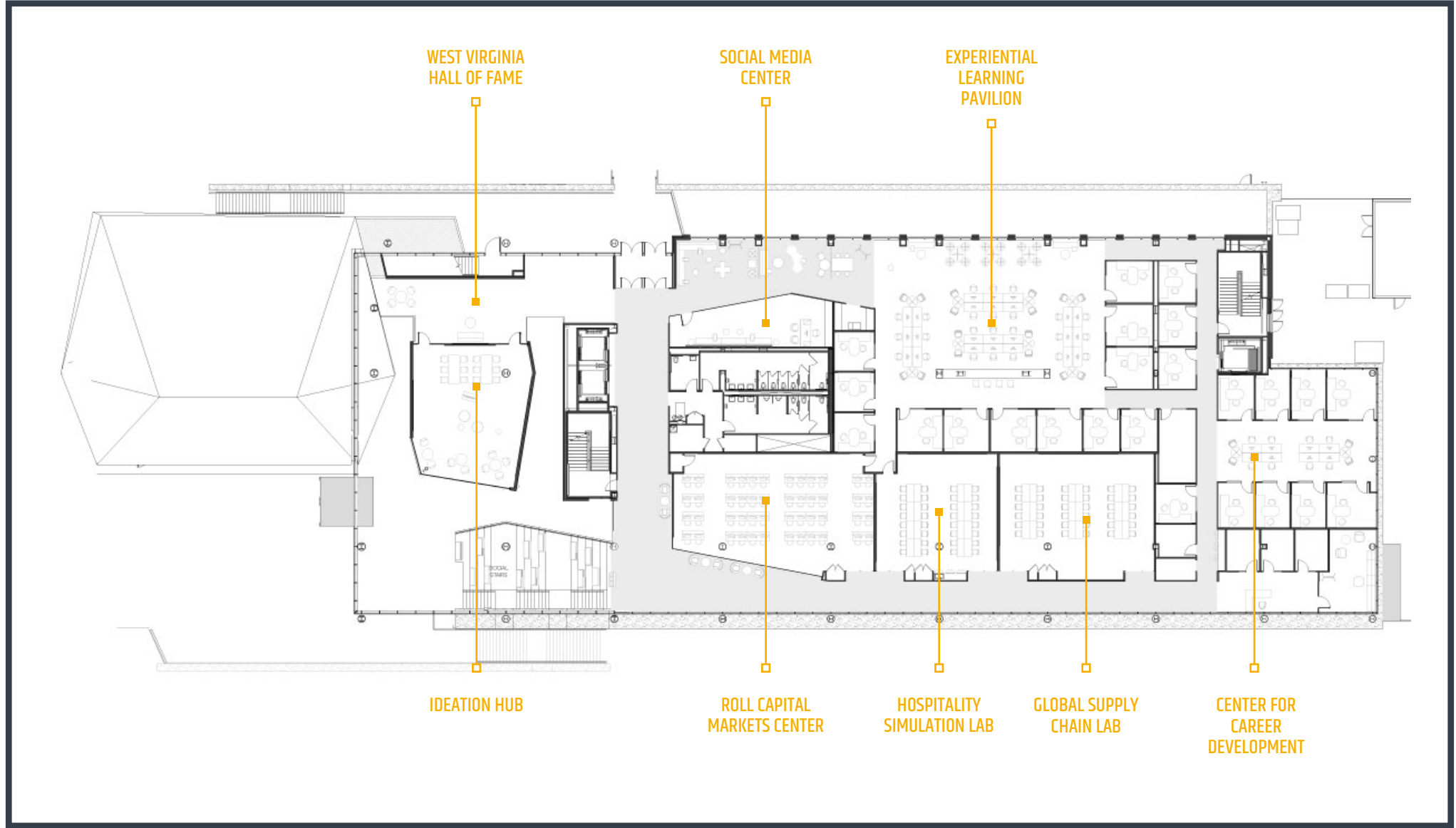

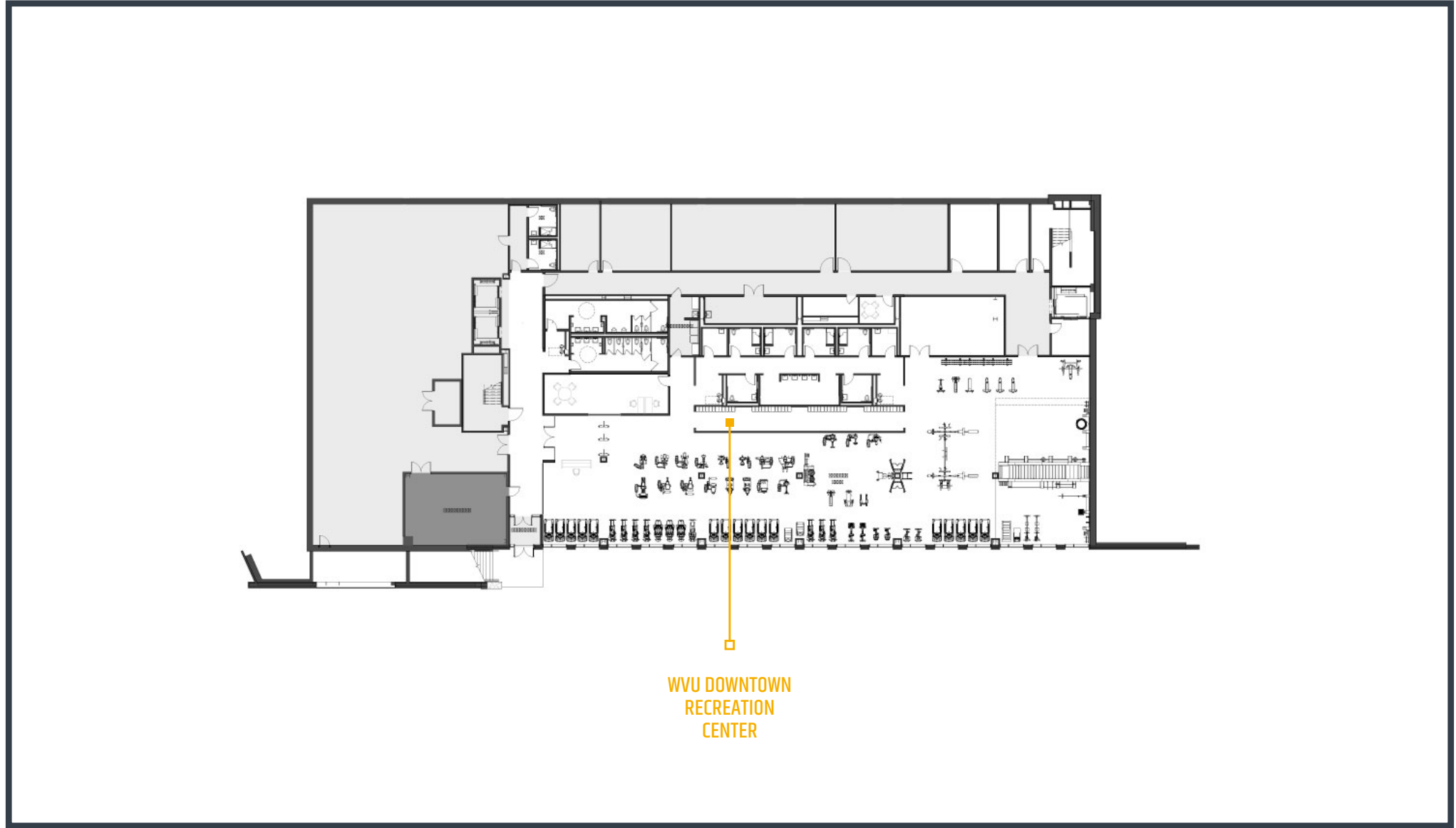
